




# MEDIA MONITORING OF VIOLENT INCIDENTS IN GHANA


## Monthly Update-July 2025

A total of eighty-seven (87) violent incidents has been recorded in the month of July 2025. Physical violence is 38 (43.7%) and Gun violence is 32 (36.8%). The remaining 17 is spread across Social, Political and Economic types of violence. The Greater Accra region is currently leading with 17 violent incidents followed by Eastern region 13 and Ashanti and Central with 11 incidents each. All 15 regions have recorded an incident, however, there were no media report of violent in the Oti region in July.



The actual 87 violent incidents in July is 43 incidents more compared to the predicted count of 44 incidents. Based on the reported 87 violent incidents the projected count for the month of August is expected to range between 57 to 74 violent incidents.

Additionally, the actual 87 incidents implies that the projection is more than half way through i.e between 31-52 incidents more to meet the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter prediction. If the incident count continues in a similar manner going forward, it is possible the 3<sup>rd</sup> qtr 2025 will see the highest violent incident period per quarter since 2022.



The range of incidents predicted is 118 to 139 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter.
